Health & Safety Adviser

The purpose of this role is to lead and provide occupational health professional advice on the delivery of medical and health services, resources and programmes for company employees.

Your responsibility and key objectives will be:

- Developing occupational health/industrial hygiene systems and prevention programmes
- Leading the development and implementation of health policies
- Providing occupational health input during design and engineering of facilities so that potential health hazards and effects of chemical, physical, biological, ergonomic and psychological agents are identified and assessed
- Maintaining a health record system
- Ensuring processes are in place to identify and investigate ill health that could be related to working in or being exposed to company activities, products or emissions
- Maintaining access to local network of health specialists
- Identifying and understanding local medical legislation and regulations
- Setting and controlling the health budget

You should be an experienced medical professional, preferably a medical doctor, or nurse with significant experience. A certification in occupational health programme/industrial hygiene would be beneficial.

You will need:

- 7-10 years experience
- Experience in providing medical cover and access to medical consultation
- Experience in managing health programmes for endemic diseases
- Understanding of medical emergency response systems
- Budget management and financial planning
- Experience managing Health & Safety operations on a rig (offshore/onshore)
