The purpose of this role is to manage robust and structured supply chain processes and practices that deliver value protection and value enhancement.

Your responsibility and key objectives will be:

- Managing the department the development of supply chain strategies
- Providing clear, coherent and effective supply chain management processes from requisition through to contract close out
- Developing a reporting system and continuously monitoring the cost base, and track costs against approved budget values
- Providing a centre for market intelligence, supply chain processes, contracting documentation and supplier management
- Supporting the business by the provision of ad hoc functional advice and appropriate supply chain resources from requisition through to post-award contract management and administration
- Introducing a demonstrable continuous improvement programme through decreasing transactional turnaround times, streamlining work processes, and working collaboratively to provide a quality and seamless customer service
- Supporting the development and use of local contractors and suppliers

You should have a degree in a business or management related subject, with a purchasing and supply qualification preferred.

You will need:

- 7-10 years at managerial level
- Substantive exposure to all disciplines and issues within the supply chain
- International exposure within an oil and gas operating environment industries (e.g. mining, extraction, utilities, transportation/logistics)
- Proven supply chain managerial experience.
